Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunshine and showers and average maximum temperatures today, with the east having the best sunshine and least showers. The showers across the west will become very heavy, squally with hail and thunder later across Wales and southwest England. Overnight East Anglia, northeast England and later Northern Ireland will be dry, clear and becoming chilly. Elsewhere showers, some heavy with thunder.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
During Sunday most places will become dry and sunny, as showers or outbreaks of rain across England and Wales die away. However showers, some heavy, will effect northeast Scotland. Monday western areas will become wet, eastern places will stay dry.
