General Situation

High pressure over Scotland will decline, bringing all but the far north under the influence of a northeasterly airstream.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in north.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north.

Fog patches, then rain for a time, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5 at first in north, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time, then northwesterly 4 or 5 later near Mull of Galloway.

Smooth or slight.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Weak trough over northeastern waters at first with high pressure soon building across, sinking south by Thursday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Westerly or northwest 3, occasionally 4 in far north and west.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional light rain in north at first.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Wednesday 02 May until 0600 UTC on

Thursday 03 May:

Northwest 3 backing westerly 4 occasionally 5 later in north and west.

Slight or moderate.

Fair at first then light rain or drizzle.

Good becoming occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3 during the evening.

Slight.

Fog or mist patches in the north by midday risk of light rain overnight in the north.

Good becoming locally moderate, and poor or very poor in fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3 becoming northeast 2 or 3 during the afternoon, .

Smooth or slight.

Risk of mist and fog patches.

Moderate to good, locally poor or very poor in fog.

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
