Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1800 UTC to 1800 UTC

#### General Situation

A strong southeasterly airflow across the United Kingdom. A weather front will affect Scotland and eastern England at first, becoming showery in the east later.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 at first and again later.

Wintry showers.

Good.

Rough or very rough, locally moderate in Moray Firth.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 7 or gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 in northeast.

Wintry showers then rain or sleet for a time.

Moderate or good.

Rough or very rough, becoming high in northeast later.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 or 7.

Wintry showers.

Good.

Rough or very rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Wintry showers, then rain or sleet for a time.

Moderate or good.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

Southeasterly 6 or 7.

Wintry showers.

Occasional rain or sleet then mainly fair.

Moderate becoming good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 around exposed headlines, later decreasing 4 or 5.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or sleet later.

Good becoming moderate later.

Moderate occasionally rough in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East veering south 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or sleet, then mainly fair.

Moderate becoming good.

Moderate becoming slight for a time.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 around exposed headlines, later decreasing 4 or 5.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or sleet later.

Moderate or good.

Moderate or rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East veering south 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or sleet then mainly fair.

Moderate becoming good.

Moderate occasionally rough.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 5 to 7.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or sleet later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in sleet.

Moderate or rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 decreasing 3 or 4, later veering south 5 to 7.

Occasional rain then mainly fair.

Moderate becoming good.

Moderate or rough.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east 6 to gale 8.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or sleet later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in sleet.

Moderate occasionally rough in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 6 or 7 veering southeast 3 or 4, later veering south 6 or 7.

Occasional rain then mainly fair.

Moderate becoming good.  
Moderate becoming rough.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast backing east 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6 later.  
Mainly fair, occasional rain in south later.  
Good.  
Moderate or rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, later veering south 6 or 7.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Moderate becoming rough in west.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast backing east 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 at times.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.  
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East veering south or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time  
but increasing 6 to gale 8 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight becoming moderate or rough.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 6 to gale 8, becoming east 5 or 6 later.  
Fair.  
Good.  
Rough becoming moderate or rough later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5, veering southeast 6 to gale 8 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Good, falling moderate at times in rain.  
Moderate or rough.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

Southeast 6 to gale 8 backing east 5 or 6.  
Wintry showers later.  
Moderate or good.

East 5 or 6 veering southeast 3 or 4, later increasing 6 to gale 8.  
Wintry showers, rain later.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde  
and the North Channel

Southeast 6 to gale 8 backing east 5 or 6.

East 5 or 6 veering southeast 3 or 4, later increasing 6 to gale 8.

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to gale 8.

Wintry showers.

Southeast 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 or perhaps storm 10 later.

Wintry showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

Rough or very rough becoming high.

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
