#### General Situation

A large area of low pressure between the faroe islands and Iceland will drift slowly east-northeastwards, maintaining rather changeable and breezy conditions across the United Kingdom inshore waters during the next day or two.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in north, then veering westerly later.

Rough or very rough to the west and north of Orkney, but elsewhere slight or moderate.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7 veering northwest 4 to 6.

Rough or very rough to the west and north of Orkney, but elsewhere slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6 veering west 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight except near Rattray Head.

Fair then showers.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, veering west later, 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in far north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Mainly slight, but occasionally moderate at first in far north.

Mainly fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 for a

time later.  
Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers later.  
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate at first near North Foreland, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Rain at times later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate near northeast Norfolk.  
Rain then fair, then showers later.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6  
in east, decreasing 3 at times in west.  
Moderate becoming slight.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, increasing 6 at times  
later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Rain then fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
West or northwest 3 to 5.  
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.  
Rain for a time later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 3 to 5.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly  
24 hour forecast:  
West 3 to 5.  
Slight or moderate in east, moderate throughout in west.  
Rain for a time, mainly later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 3 to 5.  
Slight to the east of Lizard Point, moderate to the west of Lizard Point.  
Showers.  
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in Bristol Channel, decreasing 3 at times near  
Cornwall.  
Moderate in west, slight or moderate in east.

Rain for a time, mainly later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in Bristol Channel.  
Moderate in west, slight or moderate in east.  
Showers.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 4 or 5, veering west or northwest 4 to 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers, mainly later.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 4 to 6.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate.  
Showers, mainly later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 to 6.  
Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 4 to 6.  
Moderate.  
Showers for a time later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West 5 or 6, decreasing 4 later.  
Moderate, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Rain at times later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in far north, decreasing 4 at times elsewhere.  
Moderate or rough in far north, but elsewhere slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West 4 to 6.  
Rough until later in far north, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering westerly, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near the Mull of Kintyre.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 to 6, backing southwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near the Mull of Kintyre, but becoming smooth or slight in Firth of Clyde.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west, 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough, but moderate in shelter.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, then decreasing 4 at times, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Very rough at first near Tiree, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate to the north of skye, but elsewhere moderate or rough.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, then decreasing 4 at times, then becoming variable 3 later in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far south and far north, but becoming smooth or slight later near skye.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in north, then veering westerly later.

Rough or very rough.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, then decreasing 4 at times, then becoming variable 3 later in south.

Rough or very rough becoming moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

#### General Situation

Low pressure east of Iceland will maintain a showery southwesterly flow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Gale now ceased, but southwesterly gale force 8 expected soon. Issued 03:35 UTC on Thursday 3 September 2020

Southerly veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6 in west later.  
Rough or very rough, but moderate in sheltered eastern coastal waters.  
Squally showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Friday 04 Sep until 0000 UTC on Saturday 05 Sep:  
Southwesterly veering westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in east at first.  
Rough or very rough, but moderate in sheltered eastern coastal waters.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 2 to 4 becoming northwest 4 locally 5 after dusk.  
Slight to moderate, decreasing slight locally smooth from dawn till dusk, with a low swell.  
Outbreaks of rain, drizzle and mist with isolated fog patches, clearing from the northwest overnight and the southeast during the morning.  
Moderate to poor, perhaps locally very poor, improving good from the northwest by mid-morning.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4, locally 5 till mid-morning.  
Slight, locally moderate till mid-morning, with a low swell.  
Occasional rain spreading east during evening, clearing to isolated showers overnight.  
Good, locally moderate.

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
