Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Another dull and damp day with rain at times, and feeling cold in a strong northeasterly wind, especially near eastern coasts. Drier and brighter conditions will spread to many northern and western areas by evening, then to all but eastern coastal districts by dawn. Winds easing overnight, with clear skies leading to widespread frost by morning.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will be a dry and bright but rather chilly day, with plentiful sunshine and generally light winds, though cloudier with occasional rain in the far east and, later, in the northwest too. More wet and windy weather spreading to all areas on Thursday.
