#### General Situation

Low pressure currently centred over southern Ireland will gradually fill and drift slowly towards the Bristol Channel during today. This will maintain rather cool and showery weather across most parts.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally smooth in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming north, 3 or 4.

Slight, but smooth at first in Moray Firth.

Rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable or northeast, 3 or less.

Slight, occasionally smooth in Firth of Forth.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle and fog patches, thundery showers later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming moderate or good later.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable or southeast, 3 or less.

Slight.

Thundery showers later, fog patches developing in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or cyclonic, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in north.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4.

Smooth in Firth of Clyde, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly backing northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth in Firth of Clyde, otherwise slight or moderate.

#### Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Complex low over Britain extends a trough northeast towards southern Norway.  
Slow moving occluded front continues to affect the Northern Isles.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Northeast 4, but variable 2 in the south at first.  
Slight.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, mainly south.  
Mainly good, but occasional moderate or poor in the south.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Saturday 04 Aug until 0600 UTC on Sunday 05 Aug:

North or northeast 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, mainly south.

Mainly good, but occasional moderate or poor in the south.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South to southwest 4 to 5, locally 6 in the north at first, decreasing 3 to 4 in the afternoon, locally variable 1 to 3 in the south and east, becoming 3 to 4 by morning.

Slight to moderate, locally rather rough in the north at first.

Isolated showers.

Good except in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 3 to 4, veering southwest to west 2 to 4 during the evening.

Slight in the south, moderate in the north with a swell.

Isolated showers.

Good except in showers.

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
