

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places will start dry, with the best brightness this morning across central and eastern areas. The cloud and rain already across the west of the UK will continue to spread east, with the rain turning occasionally heavy. Later Northern Ireland will become dry, and these dry conditions will follow the rain eastwards overnight. Daytime maximum temperatures close to normal.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday scattered showers for northern Scotland, and mainly dry with sunny spells elsewhere. However southwest England, Northern Ireland and Wales will become cloudier, rain arriving in the evening. Sunday showers for northern Scotland, elsewhere dry and fine, with light winds.
