Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

An area of low pressure will remain slow moving west of Ireland, with fronts and troughs moving eastwards across the United Kingdom during the next few days.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

Southeast veering south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 at times in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain at first in northeast.

Moderate or good.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly veering southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in North Channel.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery rain at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times in east.

Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery rain then fair, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth in The Minch.

Thundery rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in The Minch.

Showers.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will extend south over Shetland, with an area of low pressure slow moving to the west of the British Isles over the weekend.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

East or northeast 3 or 4, perhaps locally 5 in north later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, but very poor in fog patches.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Saturday 04 Jul until 1200 UTC on Saturday 04 Jul:

East or northeast 3 or 4, locally 5 in north.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in north.

Risk of fog patches, mainly over south.

Moderate or good, but very poor in fog patches.

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
