General Situation

A slow moving area of low pressure is centred near Iceland, bringing a cool showery westerly airflow across the United Kingdom for the next two days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Smooth at times in Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming west or southwest 4 or 5 at times.

Moderate to the west and north of Orkney, but elsewhere smooth or slight.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A cold front lying across Shetland will soon clear east

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Southerly 4 to 6 at first in east otherwise westerly or northwesterly 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally rough in far north and west.

Thundery rain at first becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Saturday 01 Aug until 0600 UTC on Sunday 02 Aug:

Westerly or southwesterly 2 to 4, but northwesterly in east at first.

Moderate, occasionally rough in far west at first.
