Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 04 June to 1200 UTC Tuesday 05 June 2012

#### General Situation

Low pressure over southeast England will move away southeastwards to be followed by a weak ridge of high pressure. A new Atlantic low will move northeast towards Northern Ireland during Tuesday with fronts moving northeastwards across most areas.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough at first in east.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, veering south or southeast, 3 or 4.  
Moderate, occasionally rough at first near Rattray Head.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, becoming variable 3, then south 3 or 4.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

North backing south or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers, fair later.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 5 or 6 for a time.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain, showers later.  
Good, becoming moderate for a time.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable then southerly later, 3 or 4.

Moderate becoming slight.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, veering southwesterly later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Showers then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first, veering southwesterly 5 to 7.

Slight becoming moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

North backing west, then southeast later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 around headlands.

Slight becoming moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate occasionally poor, becoming mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming south or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming south or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, then rain.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.  
Rain, then showers.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers, then rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain, then showers.

Moderate occasionally poor, becoming mainly good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southeast later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time.

Rain, then showers.

Moderate or poor becoming mainly good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming south or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair, rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southeast later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate for a time.

Rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southeasterly later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time in North Channel.

Rain, then showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

In north, northeasterly veering easterly, 3 or 4, in south, variable becoming southerly or southeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly, becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in west.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Smooth or slight, but moderate in far north.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight in south, slight or moderate in north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Smooth or slight at first in south, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 04 Jun 2012 at 1200 UTC until Tuesday 05 Jun 2012 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A northerly airstream over Shetland will weaken by Tuesday as a ridge of high pressure moves east over the North Sea.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun:

Northwest 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in the northeast.

Showers dying out.

Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North 4 soon decreasing 1 to 3, becoming variable this evening, then southeast to south by midnight, increasing 4 Tuesday morning, locally 5 by midday.

Becoming slight then moderate again later tomorrow.

Fair becoming cloudy with outbreaks of rain from midnight.

Good, becoming moderate to poor tomorrow.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to south 4 or 5, perhaps locally 6, veering southwest in the evening, perhaps locally 7 in the north.

Moderate to rather rough.

Rain, perhaps heavy at times, clearing later on Tuesday to occasional showers, dying out Wednesday morning.

Moderate to poor in rain, otherwise good.

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
