Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Saturday 03 October to 0000 UTC Sunday 04 October 2020

General Situation

A deep complex low will dominate southern areas through the period, with a further low to the northwest of Scotland. This will bring unsettled conditions with gales at times, severe in southwestern areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, backing east 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, increasing moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East backing northeast 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times, veering east or southeast 4 or 5 later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, increasing 5 to 7, becoming variable 2 to 4, then westerly 4 to 6
later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in east.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8, then variable 2 to 4, becoming west or
northwest 6 to gale 8 later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

West or northwest 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 at times.

Slight at times in Bristol Channel, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in west.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
- (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northerly 3 to 5, becoming northwesterly 5 to 7 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 5 to 7, veering easterly or northeasterly, 3 to 5.
Rough at times in North Channel, otherwise slight or moderate.
Rain at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Variable 2 to 4, becoming north or northwest, 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering east or northeast,
3 to 5 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough in west.

Cyclonic 4 to 6, becoming north or northeast, 3 to 5, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure will move northwards across the British Isles over the weekend
maintaining a fresh to strong east or southeasterly airflow across Shetland Waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil at time of
issue

Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in the southwest at first
Moderate becoming rough in southeast later
Occasional rain then fair
Moderate or good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 03 Oct until 0000 UTC on Sunday 04
Oct:

Southeasterly backing easterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in south later
Moderate or rough
Mainly fair then rain later
Good occasionally moderate later

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 to 6, backing north to northwest 6 to gale 8 by mid-morning,
locally cyclonic 2 to 4 in the east of the area, locally severe gale 9 in the west
of the area later.
Moderate to rough, occasionally very rough in the far west of the area.
Rain or showers, locally heavy with a risk of thunder.
Moderate to poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, backing westerly by morning, perhaps gale 8 mid-channel
later.
Rather rough to rough, perhaps occasionally moderate in the far south of the area.
Scattered showers, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, merging into persistent
rain in the evening.
Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
