Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 05 October to 1200 UTC Monday 06 October 2014

#### General Situation

A developing low will move in from the Atlantic bringing very windy and wet weather from the northwest as a ridge of high pressure moves away east. Showery, but calmer conditions will follow from the west later tomorrow.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7, backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later.

Showers then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast backing east 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 6 at times.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate, becoming high later in east.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 or 6, backing southeasterly 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, backing easterly 7 to severe gale 9 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 later in south.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high in north.

Rain at times.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, backing southeast 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Rain at times, becoming fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight becoming moderate.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming southwesterly 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight for a time in south.

Rain until later, then showers.  
Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 later.

Smooth, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time in east.

Rain until later, then showers.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later, perhaps gale 8.

Smooth slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering westerly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Rain until later, then thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering westerly 4 or 5 later in west.

Smooth or slight, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 7 or gale 8 at first in east, otherwise westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times later.

Rough becoming moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, increasing 7 to severe gale 9, veering west 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate or rough.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering west 4 or 5, increasing 7 to severe gale 9 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough for a time.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.  
Moderate or rough.  
Thunderly showers.  
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 5, backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering west or southwest and decreasing 4 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough for a time.  
Showers, then rain for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest, occasionally south, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight.  
Thunderly showers.  
Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 5 or 6, backing southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later except in far east.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough for a time.  
Showers, then rain for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thunderly showers.  
Moderate or good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 5 to 7, backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10 later, veering west or southwest 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough for a time.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southwest 4 or 5.  
Moderate becoming slight.  
Thunderly showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 5 to 7, backing southeasterly gale 8 to storm 10, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.  
Rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, except in far south.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thunderly showers.  
Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 to 7, backing southeasterly gale 8 to storm 10, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to gale 8, backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10, west west or southwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming high for a time in northwest, then becoming moderate later in east.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 6 to gale 8, backing southeasterly gale 8 to storm 10, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later in southwest.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 in south, southeasterly backing easterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Rough at times in far north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 6 to gale 8, backing southeasterly gale 8 to storm 10, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later in southwest.

Rough or very rough, becoming high for a time in west.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 in south, southeasterly backing easterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Rough becoming moderate, then becoming rough or very rough in far north later.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 05 Oct 2014 at 1200 UTC until Monday 06 Oct 2014 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

#### General Situation

Icelandic low becomes complex and extends trough over Shetland Waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southerly gale force 8 imminent, backing southeasterly severe gale force 9.

South 5 to 7 backing southeast 6 to gale 8 .  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Oct until 1200 UTC on Monday 06 Oct:

Southeasterly 7 or gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in east.  
Rough or very rough, occasionally high in east.  
Fair, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, soon becoming south to southeast, increasing 5 to 6 by midnight and 6 to gale 8 by dawn, veering southwest and moderating 4 to 5 by midday Monday.

Slight increasing rather rough to rough overnight.

Fair becoming cloudy overnight with rain by dawn, heavy at times during the morning, starting to clear towards midday.

Very good, becoming moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 to 5 temporarily veering west 3 to 4, then southwest 5 to 6 by evening and gusty near showers.

Moderate to rather rough with swell.

Any rain soon clearing scattered showers developing by evening, locally heavy with a risk of thunder.

Good except in showers.

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
