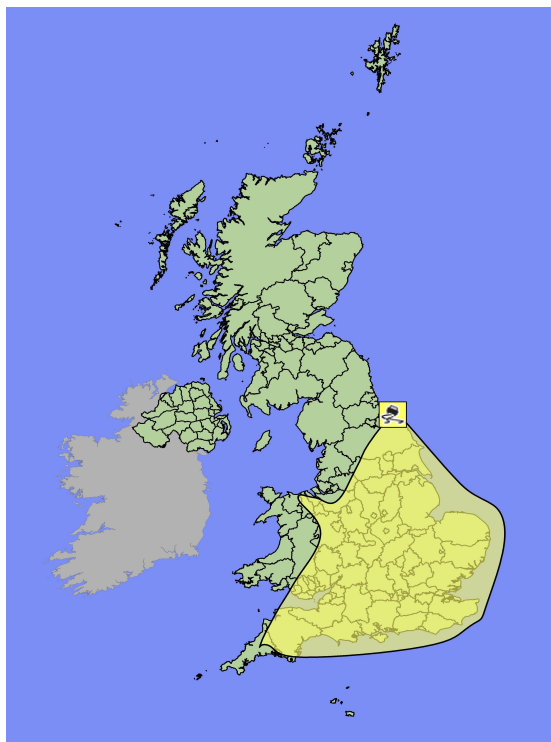




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Temperatures are expected to fall below freezing overnight across many parts of England and Wales leading to icy conditions on untreated surfaces. Areas most prone will be where snow cover has melted then refreezes, notably Lincolnshire down across the East Midlands and southeast England where ice is expected to form quickly this evening. Towards the west, across Wales, the west Midlands and into southwest England, ice will probably form a bit later on Friday evening where surfaces remain wet from earlier rain.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **17:00 on Fri, 10th Feb 2012** until **12:00 on Sat, 11th Feb 2012**

As temperatures fall below freezing on Friday evening ice is expected to form on untreated surfaces across a wide area of England along with and eastern and northern Wales and last overnight into Saturday morning. The public should be aware that driving conditions could become hazardous as a result.
