Forecast for Wednesday 03 May 2023

Weather: Cloudy start to the day with the odd spot of rain possible. Becoming brighter, especially through the afternoon with hazy sunny spells developing.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 60% becoming 95%.

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility although slightly hazy. Patchy summit cloud at first but soon lifting.

Meteorologist's View

A breezy day on the tops with gales developing in the evening.

Forecast for Thursday 04 May 2023

Weather: Dry for most of the day with sunny spells. Cloud and outbreaks of rain spreading up from the south, expected around late afternoon and early evening, becoming heavy and persistent. Strong and gusty easterly winds giving difficult walking conditions at times.

Maximum wind: Easterly 30 to 40mph with gusts 55mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 90%, becoming 60% in evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Mainly good visibility. Poor at times when rain arrives later with areas of cloud and fog developing above 500m.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 8C rising to 13C.
At 700m: Plus 4C rising to 8C.
Freezing level: Above summits.
