General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will remain dominant over the south. An Atlantic front will approach northwest Scotland through Tuesday, bringing occasional rain and showers across all parts on Wednesday.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure over the Northern North Sea will continue to decline, allowing a cold front to move into Shetland waters on Tuesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming north or northeast 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, but smooth at first east of Shetland.
Fog banks, rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jun until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Jun:
Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 in east.
Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches in east at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east at first.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 to 4, occasionally northwesterly near the french coast from late morning, becoming northerly 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fine.

Northerly 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 2 at times, backing northwesterly from early evening.
