Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

A slack pressure gradient affects the southeastern United Kingdom with fog patches on most coasts. A cold front affects the far west with rain at times.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first around Orkney, becoming variable 2 or 3.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in east at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable then easterly 2 or 3.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing northeast 3 or 4.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly backing northerly 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 with daytime sea breezes, becoming northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, with daytime sea breezes in east, becoming northerly 3 or 4 later.

Fog patches, occasional rain in far west later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southerly becoming variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, then northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far west.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight, occasionally moderate in far west later.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4 veering northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South veering north or northwest 3 or 4 increasing 4 or 5.

Rain with mist and fog patches, becoming fair later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Moderate, occasionally slight at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Occasional rain and fog patches in east at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming northwest 4 or 5.

Occasional rain and fog patches clearing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly veering northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Occasional rain and fog patches clearing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Moderate or rough at first, decreasing slight or moderate.

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
