Weather: Another dry day with a mostly cloudy start. Clouds will thin and break up during the morning with sunny spells in the afternoon and evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% improving 80% by afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Very good visibility beneath the cloud which will be extensive around 600 to 700m at first especially in north and east of area. Clouds lifting and breaking up during the morning.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Clouds breaking up to leave some strong sunshine across Northwest Highlands area with sunburn risk.

Forecast for Friday 09 Jun 2023

Weather: Staying dry with clouds breaking up during the morning to leave sunny spells.

Maximum wind: Light east or southeast winds with average speeds of 10mph, perhaps 15mph on the tops.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% at first improving 80% by afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Again very good visibility underneath the clouds. The clouds extensive at first, bases about 600 to 700m, lifting and breaking up by afternoon.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 5 Celsius rising to 19 Celsius.

At 800m: Plus 9 Celsius.

Freezing level: Above the summits.
