Headline:

Foggy in the North initially. Rainy tonight. Becoming drier tomorrow

This Evening and Tonight:

Foggy in the north, with some rain/drizzle in the east and later far northwest. Rainy further south, perhaps heavy in places.

Wednesday:

Rain gradually dying out leaving rather cloudy skies. A few bright intervals may develop, best in western areas.

Outlook for Thursday:

Windy in the far north and far south with some patchy rain/drizzle. Dry elsewhere with sunny spells after clearance of fog/frost.
