Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Friday 04 June to 0600 UTC Saturday 05 June 2021

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will gradually displace a humid and potentially thundery airmass to the east of the United Kingdom. Weak fronts will encroach from off the Atlantic and become the focus for some showers into the weekend.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

South 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming southeast 3 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate, becoming smooth later in Moray Firth.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly southeast, 3 or 4, becoming west 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming mainly moderate west and north of Orkney.

Fair then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, backing southeasterly for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate until later near Rattray Head, becoming smooth later in south.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, 3 or 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight, becoming smooth later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Showers or occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly becoming variable, 3 or 4, occasionally 2 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Occasional rain at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming northerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in far east.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly becoming variable, 3 or 4, occasionally 2 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Occasional rain at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West northwest becoming variable at times, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers at first in east.  
Good, occasionally poor at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly west or northwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southwest 3 to 5 for a time.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far west.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming mainly southwest for a time, 2 to 4.  
Mainly moderate west of Lands End, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Occasional rain or drizzle later in west.  
Good, occasionally poor later in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Mainly southerly in west, otherwise variable, 3 or 4.

Moderate at first in west, otherwise slight, but mainly smooth in Bristol Channel.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 5 until later in west, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.

Fair then occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable at times in Cardigan Bay, but occasionally 5 near St Davids Head.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less in Liverpool Bay.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable in Liverpool Bay, otherwise south or southwest 2 to 4, occasionally 5 for a time near Mull of Galloway.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional drizzle later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate until later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west, veering northerly or northwesterly 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Occasional drizzle with fog patches later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.  
Occasional rain or showers, mainly in west.  
Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor until later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly, 3 to 5.  
Slight, occasionally smooth in Firth of Clyde.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair then occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
South 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 3 to 5, veering west 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then occasionally 3 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in south.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South becoming variable, then southwest later, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then occasionally 3 later.  
Moderate, occasionally slight near Cape Wrath.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South becoming variable, then southwest later, 3 or 4.  
Moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

High pressure centred over Scandinavia will maintain a settled south or southeasterly airflow over Shetland Waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southeast veering south 3 or 4  
Mainly slight  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 04 Jun until 0600 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun:  
South or southeast 2 or 3 occasionally 4 at first  
Slight  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor

#### Channel Islands

##### 24 hour forecast:

North to northwest 2 to 4, occasionally 5 this afternoon in the far east, backing west at times.  
Smooth, locally slight.  
Occasional rain until midday in the east of the area.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West to northwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3 by midday.  
Smooth, locally slight with a low swell developing.  
Fine.  
Good or very good.

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
