#### General Situation

An area of high pressure with centres over Wales and Scotland will relocate to an area just to the northeast of Scotland where it will stay for several days, maintaining a strong ridge of high pressure southwestwards across the United Kingdom.

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

A large anticyclone covers much of Britain, the North Sea and southern Norwegian Sea, with a slack airflow over Shetland waters. A weak weather front moves south.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.
