Forecast for Wednesday 01 Jun 2022

Weather: Patchy low cloud first thing lifting and breaking. Thereafter, bright or sunny spells with the best of any sunshine later in the day. It will also be mainly dry, but a few well scattered showers are likely.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 60% early morning rising to 90% or more by afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Occasional or patchy cloud 600 to 900m early morning, otherwise any cloud above the summits. Visibility moderate or poor in any early low cloud, otherwise very good.

Forecast for Thursday 02 Jun 2022

Weather: Dry and mainly clear overnight, perhaps a few shallow mist and fog patches in the glens around dawn. Dry and bright during daylight hours with sunny spells and feeling warm.

Maximum wind: Variable 10 mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 90% or more

Low cloud and visibility: No significant cloud. Visibility very good.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 5 Celsius rising to 19 Celsius

At 800m: Plus 4 to 11 Celsius

Freezing level: Above the summits.
