Thundery rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly becoming variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery rain or showers and fog patches developing.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Slight, becoming moderate at times.

Rain or showers, thundery in east with fog patches.

Mainly northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Mainly west or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far southwest.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4, backing southerly later.

Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers, fog patches.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly south or southwest 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far south.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northwesterly then southerly 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly westerly or northwesterly 3, occasionally 4 later near Mull of Galloway.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, rain later, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time near Mull of Galloway, becoming variable then southerly later.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming northwesterly later, 3 or less.
Smooth.
Mainly fair, fog patches for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly northwesterly, backing westerly later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in northeast.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, rain later, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, becoming variable then southeasterly 3 or 4, but occasionally 5 at first in northeast.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later through

North Channel.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, rain later, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Mainly northwesterly 4, occasionally 5 through North Channel, becoming variable then southeasterly 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Rain or showers, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Variable, becoming mainly northerly later, 3 or 4.
Slight, becoming moderate in west.
Showers, rain later, fog patches.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable, mainly northwesterly at first, 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Rain, fog patches for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
Variable, mainly southerly at first, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Variable, becoming mainly northerly, 3.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.
Rain or showers, fog patches for a time.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A ridge of high pressure will continue to decay as a weak weather front edges into Shetland during Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 3 or 4.

Slight.

Outbreaks of rain, mist or fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Sunday 06 Jun:

Southeast veering south 3 or 4.

Slight.

Outbreaks of rain with mist or fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming generally west to northwest 3 to 4 by the afternoon.

Slight, locally moderate by the evening.

Misty near coasts with sea fog patches in the south scattered showers by evening.

Moderate to good but locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4, perhaps 5 for a time, backing west by the afternoon, decreasing 2 or 3 overnight and

backing south by morning.

Moderate becoming slight.

Occasional showers and some sea fog patches.

Good, locally moderate to very poor overnight.

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
