General Situation

A slight ridge of high pressure gives a slack flow across the British Isles.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 2 to 4, veering west or southwest 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Moray Firth.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest, backing south later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in south.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly later, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Slight, occasionally smooth in east.

West or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight, occasionally smooth in east.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 2 to 4, veering west or northwest later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less , then southwest 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming southwest, 2 to 4, veering west or northwest 3 to 5 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight later.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, occasional drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 3 to 5, veering west or northwest later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, fog patches for a time later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor, becoming very poor for a time later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West, backing southwest, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, veering west or northwest later, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West, backing south or southwest, 3 to 5, occasional 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time in central areas.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure over Shetland will gradually decline on Tuesday as an Atlantic low centred near Iceland pushes weather fronts in from the west

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

South or southeast 3 or 4 increasing 5 or 6
Moderate or rough
Rain later
Good, becoming moderate occasionally poor later

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 04 May until 1200 UTC on Wednesday 04 May:

South 5 or 6, veering southwest 4 later in west
Moderate, occasionally rough at first
Rain, drizzle and mist. Risk of fog patches.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 2 to 3, locally 4 at times, mainly in the south of the area, becoming variable 1 to 2 overnight, then westerly around dawn, increasing 3 to 4 later.

Smooth, locally slight at times.

Chance of a slight shower in the far southeast this afternoon occasional mist or haze, with a risk of fog patches developing by dawn tomorrow.

Moderate or good, locally poor or perhaps very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 to 4, perhaps locally 5 in the afternoon and evening, veering northwesterly overnight, backing westerly again mid-channel later.

Slight, locally smooth at times.

Occasional mist or haze and a small risk of fog patches.

Moderate or good, locally poor or perhaps very poor at times.

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
