General Situation

Pressure will remain relatively high over the United Kingdom. Atlantic fronts will affect northwestern areas at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Fair then fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 in North Channel.
Smooth or slight, but moderate for a time in North Channel.
Showers later, rain for a time later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, but 5 at first in North Channel.

Smooth or slight.

Showers and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or showers later.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable later.

Slight or moderate, but smooth in shelter.

Rain or showers for a time, fog patches later.

General Situation
