General Situation

A complex area of low pressure over the United Kingdom will gradually move away eastwards, allowing a cool northerly airflow to develop for a time. Winds will thereafter decrease as a ridge of high pressure edges eastwards.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 at first in east, otherwise northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Slight at first in east, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough becoming moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north or northeast 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later, and very rough towards Rattray Head.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Rattray Head, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South becoming variable, then north later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest, then north later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.
Slight, becoming moderate or rough.
Showers, fair later.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, decreasing 2 or 3 for a time.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Showers, mainly in south.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic, becoming north 4 or 5.
Slight, becoming moderate in north.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic, becoming northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Thundery showers, fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest, veering northwest then north later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west.
Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.
Showers, fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west.

Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Showers until later in west.
Good, occasionally moderate in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 4 or 5, veering north 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough in far south, otherwise slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Showers at first.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming north or northeast 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 3 or 4, occasionally 5, becoming north or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 5 or 6, decreasing 2 or 3, then veering south 4 or 5 later.
Moderate becoming slight.
Showers then fair.
Mainly good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly veering southerly or southeasterly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming northerly 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly veering southerly or southeasterly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time in far west.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, veering east 4 or 5, then south 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, then very rough for a time in north.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Showers fair later.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough becoming very rough for a time.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers fair later.

Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will cover the North Sea on Tuesday with a strong northeast airflow over Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northeasterly gale force 8

Northeast 5 or 6 increasing 7 or gale 8.
Moderate at first in east, otherwise rough or very rough.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 04 Nov until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 05 Nov:
Northeast 7 or gale 8, decreasing 6 in northwest.
Rough or very rough.
Showers dying out.
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west 4 to 5, locally 6 and gusty near showers, veering northwest decreasing 3 to 4 in the morning, increasing 4 to 5 in the afternoon, further veering north 5 to 6 by midnight.
Moderate to rather rough becoming slight to moderate in the morning, increasing moderate to rather rough in the evening.
Scattered showers risk of thunder.
Good except in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 to 6, decreasing 4 to 5 by noon, and 2 to 3 in the evening.
Moderate to rather rough, decreasing slight to moderate in the afternoon with a low swell, then slight in the evening.
Isolated showers.
Mainly good.

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
