Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Friday 02 August to 0600 UTC Saturday 03 August 2019

#### General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure extends southwards across the British Isles today. The ridge will then move slowly eastwards on Saturday, allowing an Atlantic frontal system to approach western areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Fog patches near Orkney, dispersing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor near Orkney.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming east or northeast 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 2 or 3, becoming variable 1 or 2.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Variable 1 or 2, becoming easterly 2 or 3, occasionally 4 in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming south or southeast 2 to 4, then becoming variable later.

Smooth at first in east, otherwise slight, becoming moderate later west of Lizard Point.

Showers later in west.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 or 2, then east or southeast 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in east.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast, becoming variable, 2 to 4.  
Slight, occasionally smooth in east, becoming moderate later in far west.  
Showers later in west.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming east or southeast 2 to 4 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight in southwest.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3, then south or southeast 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair at first, then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3, then east or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Showers for a time near shore.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 1 to 3 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fair at first, then showers.

Variable 1 to 3, becoming easterly or southeasterly 2 to 4 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight at first in North Channel.

Showers for a time near shore.  
Good.

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in North Channel.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or showers later.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northwest to north, 1 to 3, increasing locally 4 in the south of the area for a time this afternoon and evening, veering easterly 2 to 4 overnight.

Smooth, perhaps locally slight.

Mist or fog patches, near the french coast early morning and perhaps in the far west of the area through the rest of today and tonight.

Good, locally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Locally variable 1 to 3 in the far south and the far west of the area otherwise easterly 3 to 4, increasing locally 5 for a time in the late afternoon and evening generally becoming southwest to west 2 to 4 towards dawn on Sunday.

Smooth becoming slight, with a low swell developing by Sunday morning.

Slight risk of mist or fog patches in the far west of the area early morning risk of isolated showers from late morning.

Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps locally poor or very poor.

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
