Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in east.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers, then fair, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, thundery rain later, fog patches developing.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Shower then fair, fog patches at first, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time, backing southerly later in west.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain with fog patches, then fair, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, but smooth in east.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time, backing south later.

Slight or moderate, but smooth in east.

Occasional rain with fog patches, then fair, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming northwest later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far south.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest backing south, 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time in far south.

Occasional rain or showers with fog patches, then fair, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming northwesterly later, 3 or 4 increasing 5 in west later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, rain later, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in west, backing west later.

Slight.

Occasional rain or showers with fog patches, then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northwesterly 3 or 4 occasionally 5 later.

Smooth becoming slight.

Fair, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4 occasionally 5, backing westerly 3 or less.

Slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Showers, rain later, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rain or showers with fog patches, then fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A ridge of high pressure east of Shetland will continue to decline as a weak weather front edges into Shetland over Shetland from the west later Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southeast 3 or 4.
Slight.
Isolated rain or drizzle, mainly north.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 06 Jun until 1200 UTC on Sunday 06 Jun:

South to southeast 3 or 4. decreasing occasional variable 2.
Slight.
Isolated rain or drizzle, mainly north. Isolated fog patches.
Mainly moderate. Very poor in any fog patches.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 3 to 4, backing west in the morning, 4 occasionally 5.

Slight, becoming moderate tomorrow.

Misty, with fog in the south of the area, thinning later scattered showers from this evening.

Moderate, locally poor to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4, occasionally 5 at first, decreasing 2 to 3 overnight, backing south Monday morning.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fog patches at first occasional showers clearing overnight.

Good, locally moderate to very poor at first.

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
