Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

High pressure persists over the United Kingdom with a weak cold front gradually losing its identity across Wales and central England.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwest, backing southwest later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4.

Showers.

Good.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north at first, locally slight in Moray Firth.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly, backing southwesterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north at first.

Isolated showers.

Good.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 3 or 4 later.

Fair.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Northerly veering northeasterly 3 or less, occasionally 4 in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

North veering northeast 3 or less.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:
North veering east 3 or less.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Smooth or slight.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:
North veering southeast 3 or less.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Slight.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:
North becoming variable 3 or less.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Smooth or slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:
North 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Slight.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:
North or northwest becoming variable 2 or 3, increasing southwest 3 or 4 later.
Fair.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:
Northwest becoming variable 3 or less, then south 3 or 4 later.
Mainly fair, occasional drizzle for a time.
Moderate or good.
Slight in south, moderate or rough in north.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:
Northwest becoming variable 3 or less, then south 3 or 4 later.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:
Northwest becoming variable 3 or less, then south 4 or 5 later.
Mainly fair, occasional drizzle later.
Moderate or good.
Moderate or rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:
Northwest backing south 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.
Mainly fair, occasional drizzle later.
Moderate or good.
Moderate or rough, but very rough around Outer Hebrides at first.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing southwest 3 or 4.
Showers.

Good.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.

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
