Forecast for Sunday 07 Feb 2021

Weather: Ranges north of Dornoch across to Lochinver will see snow showers through the day, locally giving some moderate falls of snow. Elsewhere a lot of dry and bright weather expected, although the odd snow shower possible during the afternoon.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 75% across the far north as snow showers pass by, else little in the way of low cloud expected.

Visibility: Becoming poor in snow showers across the far north as cloud lowers to 700 to 800 metres, otherwise mostly very good with great air clarity.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Fresh snow will be blowing around reducing visibility and covering fresh tracks.

Forecast for Monday 08 Feb 2021

Weather: Little change. Remaining very cold with occasional snow showers in the far north, mostly dry and sunny elsewhere.

Maximum wind: Gusts 25 to 35 mph on the higher tops.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 75% in the far north, only small amounts of low cloud expected elsewhere.

Visibility: Poor in snow or blowing snow, and occasionally in cloud down to 700 metres as snow showers pass by. Otherwise very good with great air clarity.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 8 rising to minus 1 Celsius
At 800m: Minus 6 Celsius
Freezing level: 200 metres or less
