Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Most areas will be cloudy today and there will be a few patches of  
rain and drizzle and southwestern areas will be affected by showers  
this morning, some heavy with a risk of thunder. The far northwest of  
Scotland will be brighter after early frost and fog clears.  
Temperatures will be generally similar to yesterday.  
Tonight most parts will be affected by outbreaks of rain, some of the  
rain becoming heavy in southern and southwestern areas.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A fairly cloudy spell is expected with pockets of light rain or  
drizzle but also a good deal of dry weather.
