for the period 1200 UTC Tuesday 05 June to 1200 UTC Wednesday 06 June 2012

General Situation

All areas will be unsettled and at times rather windy for the foreseeable future as low pressure becomes established across the United Kingdom.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first, increasing 7 for a time in northeast.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering south for a time, 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming rough for a time.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Moderate.

Mainly fair, then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate, becoming mainly slight later.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South backing southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, veering south for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming mainly slight.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5 backing southeasterly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly later.
Slight or moderate.

Rain for a time, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, backing southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first, veering southwesterly 5 to 7.
Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain for a time, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, backing southerly 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first.
Slight becoming moderate.

Rain then showers.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly backing southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Moderate, becoming slight in east.

Thundery showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Moderate.

Rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first, increasing 7 at times later.

Moderate, becoming rough later in west.

Thundery showers then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly, backing southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later in west.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in southwest.
Thundery showers then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeast becoming cyclonic, then southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then rain.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, becoming cyclonic, then southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate for a time.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, backing east or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Mainly fair, fog patches for a time, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Mainly southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in North Channel.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly southeasterly 3 or 4, backing easterly 4 or 5 later.

Mainly slight.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Mainly southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in North Channel.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly southeasterly 3 or 4, backing easterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, but moderate at first in North Channel.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4 in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise northeasterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Smooth or slight south of skye, slight or moderate north of skye.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northeasterly 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, but mainly smooth or slight near skye.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, but 5 or 6 in far north.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in far north.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Tuesday 05 Jun 2012 at 1200 UTC until Wednesday 06 Jun 2012 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure will soon build over Shetland waters and persist until around late Wednesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North or northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3 soon, then east or southeast 2 or 3, occasionally 4, later.

Slight or moderate.
Isolated showers.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 06 Jun until 1200 UTC on Wednesday 06 Jun:

East or southeast 3 increasing 4 or 5 soon.

Slight or moderate.

Isolated showers, mainly in east.

Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast to south 4 or 5, locally 6 in the north, veering southwest this evening, decreasing 3 to 4 south of jersey.

Moderate locally rather rough in the north.

Rain, locally heavy, clearing this evening to isolated showers.

Moderate to poor in rain, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4, locally 5 in the north, backing south, temporarily decreasing 2 to 4 late afternoon, increasing 5 to 6 on Thursday, locally 7 in the north.

Moderate to rather rough decreasing for a time Wednesday evening, becoming rather rough or rough on Thursday.

Occasional showers then rain from late Wednesday.

Good except in showers or rain.

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
