Forecast for Sunday 07 Jan 2024

Weather: Most staying dry with the best of the weak winter sunshine expected across western ranges. The few light showers that do appear, snow level 400-500m, will be focused across the cloudier east and north of the Park area.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90% in south and west 70% in east

Low cloud and visibility: Good or very good becoming moderate or poor in rain showers, very poor in snow showers and within cloud with bases quite occasionally lowering 600m in the east, infrequently so in west.

Forecast for Monday 08 Jan 2024

Weather: Most staying dry again with the best of the sunshine in the west. Some chance of a few light showers across eastern areas, snow level 300m. Severe wind chill at height.

Maximum wind: East or Northeast 15-20mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90% in west and 80% in east

Low cloud and visibility: Good or very good becoming moderate or poor in rain showers, very poor in snow showers and within cloud with bases occasionally to 600m in east, infrequently so in west.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Minus 1 Celsius increasing 8 Celsius during the afternoon
At 600m: Minus 3 Celsius
Freezing level: 400m
