Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0600 UTC to 0600 UTC

General Situation

A deep area of low pressure over Denmark early on Monday morning will move northeast to be centred over the Baltic Sea by midday Monday. A weak ridge of high pressure following from the west will build over the United Kingdom during Monday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in east and around Orkney.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later north of Orkney.

Rain or sleet showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east and around Orkney, becoming variable 3 or less,

then becoming southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate or rough, but very rough at first north of Orkney.

Wintry showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly backing northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, decreasing 3 or 4 in south.

Moderate, occasionally rough near Rattray Head.

Rain or sleet showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, but 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first near Rattray Head.

Rain or sleet showers, becoming mainly fair.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasionally wintry, then mainly fair.

Variable 3 or less, becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate, occasionally poor at first in Thames estuary.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

Westerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Variable 3 or less, becoming easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

West 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Occasionally moderate at first in east, otherwise slight becoming smooth.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Moderate at first in west, otherwise slight.

24 hour forecast:

increasing 3 to 4 in the

afternoon and backing east in the evening.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fair, but a risk of fog patches near french coasts early morning occasional

rain in the south from late

afternoon.

Good, perhaps poor near french coasts in the morning.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 to 4, occasionally 5 in the south, backing northeast for time, veering southeast and increasing 4 to 5 later.
Slight, becoming moderate in the northwest of the area.
Fair, but a risk of mist or fog near french coasts Tuesday morning.
Good, perhaps locally very poor in the morning.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A deep low near Denmark and southern Sweden will track northeast towards the Gulf of Finland.
Meanwhile a ridge will be slow moving near to the Faeroes.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

North or northwest 5 to 7.
Rough or very rough.
Wintry showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 01 Mar until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Mar:

North or northwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time.
Rough or very rough.
Wintry showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

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
