General Situation

High pressure close to southwest England and low pressure near Iceland will maintain a westerly or southwesterly airflow across the United Kingdom. Winds will be strong at times in the north.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, becoming variable, then southerly later, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate in east, rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough in north.

Occasional rain, mainly in north.

Occasional drizzle, mainly in north.
Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 3 or 4, backing southerly 4 or 5 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.
Occasional drizzle, mainly in north.
Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.
Moderate or rough, but very rough at first in northwest.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Southwesterly, backing southerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 in north.
Moderate or rough.

The Minch - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Anticyclone over southern UK will maintain a fresh westerly airflow over Shetland waters with troughs giving unsettled weather conditions.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south and west.
Moderate or rough, but very rough in west.

Rain, becoming fair later.
Moderate or poor becoming good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Sep until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 03 Sep:

West 4 or 5 veering northwest 5 or 6, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight in sheltered eastern waters.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 2 to 3, locally 4 at times, veering northeast 1 to 3 overnight.
Slight.

Mist patches at first and on Tuesday.

Good, locally moderate to poor at first and later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 1 to 3, becoming variable by Tuesday afternoon, locally 4 by evening.

Smooth or slight.

Mist patches at first and on Wednesday.
