Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

General Situation

Pressure will continue to be high across the United Kingdom, with a weak cold front moving southwards across most areas during Tuesday and Wednesday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly backing northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in east.

Fog patches at first.

Good, occasionally very poor at first.

Slight but smooth for a time in south.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly backing northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in north.

Fog patches for a time.

Good, but very poor for a time.

Smooth becoming slight.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeast 3 or 4 later.

Fog patches for a time.

Good, but very poor for a time.

Smooth becoming slight.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or less, veering north 3 or 4.

Fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, but very poor for a time.

Smooth becoming slight.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Slight or moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, but 6 for a time in east.

Fair.

Good becoming moderate.

Slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, backing north later.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

East backing north 3 or 4.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northwest 3 or 4.

Fair.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Smooth or slight.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north 4 or 5.

Fair.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Slight.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Fog patches then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate, but mainly smooth in minch.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

North 3 or 4, backing northwest 5 or 6.

Showers.

Good.

Slight becoming moderate.

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
