Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Cloudy across much of England and Wales but generally dry. Some cloud
breaks are expected, especially across western Wales and southwest
England, allowing sunny periods. Bright spells should also develop
elsewhere during the day. Strong winds across the south will make it
feel cold. Scotland and Northern Ireland will be generally dry with
some bright or sunny spells, once patchy fog has cleared. However,
the far north and northwest will be cloudy with patchy rain or
drizzle.

Generally dry tonight, too, with fog and perhaps some frost.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rather cloudy on both Friday and Saturday but many places should
remain dry.
