Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 05 June to 0000 UTC Tuesday 06 June 2017

General Situation

Low pressure will become slow-moving across the United Kingdom for the next couple of days, bringing an unseasonably windy period of weather to many areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southeast 3 or 4, becoming east 4 or 5, then cyclonic, mainly northeast, 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight until later in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, mainly northeasterly 5 or 6, becoming northerly 6 to gale 8 in north, and perhaps later in east.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in northwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time, then becoming variable later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, perhaps northwest gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, then backing southeast later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast, becoming cyclonic, then west, 5 or 6, increasing 7 later, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing south 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, veering west 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.
Rain, showers later.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly, backing southerly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Showers at first, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly 5 or 6, veering westerly or southwesterly 6 or 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Mainly moderate.
Rain then thundery showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly, backing southerly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in west.
Rain later.
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly, veering westerly or southwesterly, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate or rough.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, increasing 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.
Fair, then rain.
Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South veering west, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate or rough.
Rain then thundery showers.
Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly, backing southerly, 4 at first in east, otherwise 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 except in far east, veering northwesterly later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.
Rain for a time.
Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate or rough.
Showers, thundery at times.
Mainly good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest backing south, becoming cyclonic, then becoming northwesterly later, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair, then rain, showers later in west.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.
Rain at first in east, otherwise squally showers.
Moderate or poor at first in east, otherwise mainly good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest, becoming cyclonic, then northwest later, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.
Fair.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate, occasionally rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, then becoming cyclonic later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.
Rain.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic becoming northwest, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 or 4, then northwest 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Rain at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 5 or 6.
Mainly moderate.
Rain at first, then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southeasterly, becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time in southeast, then becoming northwesterly 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in southeast.
Rain then showers.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in North Channel.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.
Showers.
Mainly good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 at first for a time near the Mull of Galloway, becoming northwesterly 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near Mull of Galloway.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in North Channel.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in North Channel.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, becoming cyclonic, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, then becoming northwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally slight in shelter.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, backing northerly or northeasterly, then northwesterly later in south, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight until later in central areas, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly at first in north, otherwise northerly or northwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, backing northerly or northeasterly, then northwesterly later in south, 4 or 5.

Moderate.

Showers, occasional rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly at first in north, otherwise northerly or northwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Moderate, becoming rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 05 Jun 2017 at 0000 UTC until Monday 05 Jun 2017 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

An area of low pressure will become slow moving across the mainland through Monday, bringing a freshening easterly flow to the Shetland Waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 or 4.
Slight in sheltered east, otherwise moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 05 Jun until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 06 Jun:

East or southeast 3 or 4, backing east of northeast 4 or 5.
Slight at first in sheltered east, otherwise moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 to 4, backing southerly 4 to 5 by dawn, increasing 5 to 6 by midday, then 7 to gale 8 by evening, veering northwest 6 to 7 by Tuesday.
Slight to moderate, becoming moderate to rather rough by early afternoon, then rather rough to rough by evening.
Rain spreading in from the west from around noon, perhaps heavy with a risk of thunder, mainly clearing by Tuesday.
Good or very good, becoming moderate to poor from midday.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 6 to 7, perhaps occasionally gale 8 at first.
Rather rough to rough.
Isolated showers, becoming more frequent from dawn, dying out through the evening.
Moderate, perhaps poor in showers.
