### Forecast for Friday 10 Jun 2022

**Weather:** Long clear spells developing through the early hours giving way to a sunny start to the morning. Cloud will bubble up with a few showers developing towards midday, the showers may be heavy at times through the afternoon but will pass quickly in the strong winds. Becoming mainly dry through the evening.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** Close to 100% at first but 75% from mid-morning rising to 90% by early afternoon.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Occasional cloud above 450m developing by mid-morning then rising to leave just small amounts below summit level, mainly in association with showers. Away from cloud visibility very good falling briefly in showers.

## Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Gusts around 65mph over ridges and summits. Significant chill effect on higher summits despite some strong sunshine.

## Forecast for Saturday 11 Jun 2022

**Weather:** Mainly dry with clear or sunny spells to the north and east of the Plateau through the morning, but cloudier to the south and west with some outbreaks of mainly light rain. Cloud in the south and west will break up for the afternoon to leave most places dry through the afternoon, although the odd shower is possible, with sunny spells.

**Maximum wind:** Southwesterly 35-45mph, gusts around 75mph over ridges and summits, easing a little in evening.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** Around 40% to the south and west of the Plateau through much of the morning, otherwise around 90%.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Periods of cloud above about 600-750m south and west of the Plateau through much of the morning, otherwise only small amounts of cloud below the summits. Away from cloud visibility good or very good falling to several kilometres in rain and briefly in showers.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Around plus 9 Celsius rising to plus 18 Celsius by day.

**At 800m:** Around plus 7 Celsius.

**Freezing level:** Above summits.
