Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will be slow moving to the north and west of Scotland with a showery airstream covering much of the United Kingdom.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north later.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 in north.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Showers.

Good.

Slight.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Showers.

Good.

Slight.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering westerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mainly moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times especially around exposed headlands.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mainly moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around exposed headlands.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.
Moderate occasionally slight.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering west 3 or 4, increasing 5 later.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.
Moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering west 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Showers.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering west 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Showers.
Good.
Slight occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 or 5, later veering west.
Showers.
Good.
Slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Mainly west or southwest 2 or 3, occasionally 4.
Showers, rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.
Slight or moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering west 2 or 3, increasing 4 at times.
Showers.
Good.
Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering northwest 2 or 3.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or poor becoming good.
Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 3 or 4 veering north 2 or 3.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or poor becoming good.
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming east 2 or 3, later backing north 3 or 4.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate occasionally slight.

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
