General Situation

An area of low pressure will approach from the west on Tuesday, bringing fronts and stronger winds for a time.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing south 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Moderate or rough north and west of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Occasional rain, fair for a time.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing south 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 to 7, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate.

Rain, fair later.

Moderate or good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Mainly slight.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time, veering west 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain, fair later.

Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, but variable for a time, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain, fair later.

Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Slight.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Mainly slight.

Rain, fair later.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, backing southerly later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times in lyme bay, backing southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, veering west or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West backing south, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 to 7, veering west or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west and south.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time, backing south and increasing 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 to 7, veering west or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time, backing south and increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 to 7, veering west or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southwest 3 or 4, becoming south, and increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 to 7, veering west or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in North Channel.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming southerly, and increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 to 7, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in North Channel.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west or southwest, 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or drizzle, fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, becoming variable, then west later, 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 01 Jul 2013 at 1800 UTC until Tuesday 02 Jul 2013 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure declines overnight, as a depression moves northeast through tomorrow, pushing fronts across Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwest backing south 4 or 5.

Rough, but moderate just east of Shetland.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul:

South 4 or 5, backing southeast later.

Moderate, but rough to the northwest at first.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 2 to 4, backing south to southeast decreasing 1 to 3 overnight, veering south to southwest increasing 3 to 4 by midday, further increasing 4 to 5 in the afternoon.

Slight becoming moderate in the north later tomorrow afternoon.

Occasional rain from early to mid-afternoon.

Good, locally moderate in rain later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 to 5, perhaps locally 6 mid-channel, veering west overnight.

Slight to moderate, perhaps locally rather rough mid-channel.

Occasional rain or drizzle clearing overnight further drizzle with a risk of fog patches later Wednesday afternoon.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor in rain.
