Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0600 UTC to 0600 UTC

General Situation

Low pressure in the Atlantic will push a series of frontal systems across the United Kingdom from the west. A new deep area of low pressure will move northeast across the United Kingdom on Wednesday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Rattray Head.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, backing east or southeast, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

Slight or moderate.

Squally showers.

Southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time, backing southerly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time.

Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time, backing southerly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Squally showers.

Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time, then becoming south or southwest 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time, occasionally 4 later.

Moderate becoming rough, occasionally very rough later west of the Lizard.

Squally showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.

Rough, occasionally very rough west of the Lizard.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time, occasionally 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in southwest.

Squally showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, bce good.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, then northwest 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, then northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast, then becoming cyclonic, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, rain later.
