Forecast for Wednesday 01 Feb 2023

Weather: A cloudy day with rain at times. Drier and somewhat clearer weather will edge northwards from mid-afternoon onwards.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 50%

Low cloud and visibility: Extensive cloud expected around 700 to 900 metres for a good part of the day, this will become less extensive from mid-afternoon onwards.

Meteorologist's View

Strong, gusty summit winds will lead to slow progress and a notable wind chill

Forecast for Thursday 02 Feb 2023

Weather: Some rain for a time in the early hours. Otherwise a cloudy and mainly dry day. Strong winds at height

Maximum wind: Westerly winds with average speeds of 35 mph, gusting to 55 mph on the higher tops

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 70%

Low cloud and visibility: Generally good visibility with good air clarity, patchy cloud down to 600 to 800 metres at times

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 5 rising to 11 Celsius
At 700m: Plus 6 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits
