Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Scotland will start cloudy with outbreaks of rain. However, this should clear away northwards during the morning. Southern England will get off to a slow start with low cloud, mist and drizzle, but this will clear southeastwards. Thereafter, most places will be dry with increasing amounts of sunshine, although a few showers are likely, especially for Northern Ireland and northern England. It will be a warm day, and humid too, but there will be quite a strong west or southwesterly wind.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Mostly dry, warm and humid with some sunshine once early low cloud clears. However, some rain is likely for the northwest later on Monday and during Tuesday.
