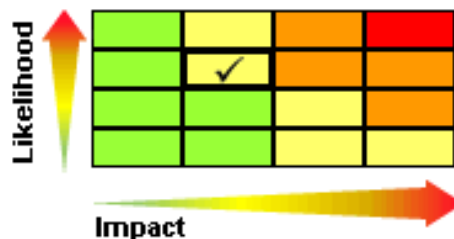
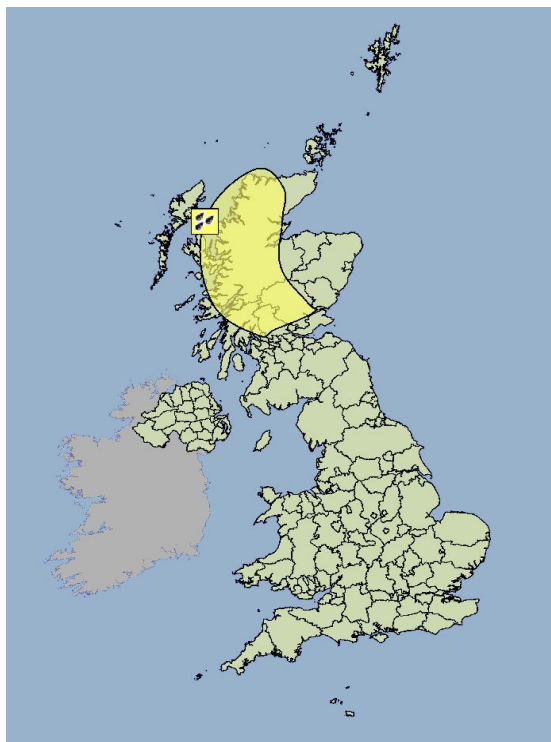




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Heavy and thundery showers will develop this afternoon. Although some areas will stay dry, 20-30mm in a short period of time is possible.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **14:00 on Sat, 27th May 2017** until **23:00 on Sat, 27th May 2017**

Scattered heavy and thundery showers will develop in the afternoon, some accompanied by hail and thunder. This may lead to some localised flooding, especially on the roads with some travel disruption possible. Showers will die away through the evening.

This is an update to lower the severity of possible impacts but extend the area further southwards.
