General Situation

Weakening weather fronts will move eastwards across all areas during Monday.
Thereafter, pressure will build with high pressure becoming centred over
Scandinavia during Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first near Cape Wrath,
becoming variable 3 at times in south.

In north, moderate or rough, occasionally very rough, in south, slight or
moderate.

Moderate west of Lizard Point, otherwise slight occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Slow moving low north of Iceland extends troughs towards Shetland while high pressure builds to the south by Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north and west.
Moderate or rough, increasing very rough in west.

Occasional rain or showers later.
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 02 Sep until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Sep:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, soon increasing 6 for a time in northwest.

Moderate or rough but very rough at first in west, becoming slight in lee of east Shetland.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 2 or 3, occasionally 4 in the north, veering northerly late evening, then northeast by morning.

Slight.

Occasional light rain or drizzle this evening and overnight, with a risk of fog patches, clearing by morning.

Good becoming moderate to very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northeast 3 to 4, veering east in the evening.

Slight with swell.
