General Situation

A weak area of low pressure over Ireland will fill and eventually lose its identity early on Friday. An area of high pressure will then build over Scotland as low pressure develops over France.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first north of Orkney.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 2 in east.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Northeast 4 or 5 veering east 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west later.

Variable 3 or less becoming easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north later.

East or northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Bristol Channel.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 2 to 4, backing northeasterly in the morning, increasing 3 to 5 around midday.

Slight, locally smooth.

Isolated showers, mainly around dawn and after dusk, perhaps more widespread and locally heavy by midnight.

Good, locally moderate or perhaps poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 3 to 5, occasionally 6 mid-channel after dawn, decreasing 2 to 4 in the evening, locally variable 1 to 3 in the south of the area.

Slight, increasing moderate in the northwest of the area by dawn, occasionally rather rough mid-channel later.

Rain or showers, perhaps locally heavy, likely clearing in the morning, but developing again around dusk slight chance of mist patches.

Good, locally moderate or perhaps poor at times.

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
