



# National Severe Weather Warning Service



**Chief Forecasters Assessment**

Hot and humid air over the eastern side of the country will gradually be replaced by fresher air from the west early next week. Before that thundery showers will form on the boundary between these air masses and these have the potential for torrential downpours, hail and gusty winds.

With considerable uncertainty in the location of these storms, further updates to this alert are to be expected.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Rain**

Valid from **00:05 on Sun, 20th Jul 2014** until **23:55 on Sun, 20th Jul 2014**

Heavy, thundery showers are likely to develop in eastern and northeastern parts of England through the morning before moving northwestwards into eastern Scotland later. Not everywhere will see a storm, but where they occur torrential downpours are possible with lightning, hail and locally strong wind gusts.

The public should be aware of the risk of disruption from any of these elements.
