Forecast for Thursday 02 Nov 2023

Weather: Dry Thursday morning with clear then sunny spells. Cloudier afternoon and evening with rain extending to eastern areas such as Caithness hills and around Ben Wyvis. Staying dry, brighter over hills close to West Coast.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 70% reducing 40% in east during afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility although misty in some of the glens at first. Occasional cloud cover above about 600 to 700m. Visibility becoming poor in east of area during afternoon as rain edges in with more extensive cloud cover.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Note strengthening wind and feeling bitterly cold over higher ridges and summits.

Forecast for Friday 03 Nov 2023

Weather: Mainly cloudy with further outbreaks of rain, most persistent and heavier over hills of Caithness and towards Ben Wyvis. Drier, brighter over mountains of Knoydart, Skye and Torridon.

Maximum wind: Strong northeast winds, average speeds of 25 to 30mph with gusts 45mph on the tops.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% in northeast, 60% in southwest of area.

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility in southwest of area with patchy cloud above 700m with a canopy of cloud above many of the tops. Misty conditions over north Highlands and hill towards Great Glen with poor visibility in more persistent rain. Also more extensive clouds in the north lower down the hills.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 5 Celsius rising to 9 Celsius.

At 800m: Plus 4 Celsius.

Freezing level: 1400m.
