Forecast for Tuesday 09 Nov 2021

Weather: A bright start with sunny spells with occasional showers spreading east from late morning. The showers become occasionally heavy this afternoon and may merge to give a longer spell of rain or summit snow in the late afternoon.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: Around 75%, falling to 25% for a time in the late afternoon.

Visibility: Occasional, becoming periods of cloud for a time in the late afternoon, above 600-750m. Very good or excellent, but several kilometres in any snow showers

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Increasing chill effect through the day. Gusts around 60mph over ridges and summits.

Forecast for Wednesday 10 Nov 2021

Weather: Clear or sunny spells and occasional showers, these falling mainly as snow on the Munro's. Showers may develop into a longer period of rain or snow through the evening.

Maximum wind: Southwesterly 25-30mph, with gusts around 50mph over ridges and summits through much of the day but perhaps 60mph in evening. A significant chill effect is expected.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: Around 60%, chances falling during the evening.

Visibility: Occasional or periods above 600-750m. Otherwise visibility very good or excellent falling to just a few kilometres in snow showers and in any more persistent rain and snow in evening.

Temperature: **Glens:** Around plus 2 or 3 Celsius at dawn rising to plus 10 or 11 Celsius by day

At 800m: Around plus 2 Celsius

Freezing level: Around 900m, rising a little during the evening
