General Situation

A large, slow-moving area of high pressure centre over the United Kingdom will bring settled conditions to most areas, although fog patches are likely at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure will be slow moving over UK and North Sea, while an Icelandic low will move east towards Norwegian Sea during Thursday and into Friday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southwesterly gale force 8 expected later. (Issued at 2130 UTC on 30th October 2015)

Southwesterly 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 at first in far north, backing westerly 5 or 6.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in north.

Mainly fair at first, rain or drizzle later.
Mainly good, occasionally moderate perhaps later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Friday 02 Oct until 1800 UTC on Friday 02 Oct:

Westerly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 later in north.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in north.
Rain or drizzle at first, fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate perhaps poor at first.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 5 to 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 to 5 Friday afternoon.

Slight to moderate in the south, moderate occasionally rather rough in the north and west.

Fair or fine.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to northeast 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight, becoming northerly or variable 2 to 4 in the afternoon.

Slight, occasionally moderate in the north at first.

Fair becoming rather cloudy overnight.
